Vendor Contract Information
August 7 – 10, 2025

- 1) The Cuming County Fair is a public forum of limited duration and exists in part to provide a means for a great number of exhibitors to temporarily present their products or views, be they commercial, religious or political, to a large number of people in an orderly, safe, secure and efficient fashion.
- 2) **Set-up times:** **Wednesday, August 6th: 10:30 am – 9 pm**
 Thursday, August 7th: 10:00 am – noon
- 3) Arrangements for late arrival must be made with the Secretary prior to Thursday noon, or the space will be leased to another exhibitor and refunds will not be issued.
- 4) **Commercial buildings will be open: 10:00 am – 10:00 pm**
 Buildings will not be unlocked prior to 10:00 am
- 5) Exhibitors must bring their own tables, chairs and supplies to decorate booth. Electrical outlets are provided for indoor booths.
- 6) Signing of this contract is agreement to conduct business in accordance with rules, regulations and policies of the Ag. Society. Under no circumstances will exhibits or merchandise of a questionable nature or of a demoralizing tendency be conceded or in any manner be tolerated upon the grounds. If said is found to be true by the Fair Board this contract will be considered void and concessionaire will be removed from the grounds.
- 7) Location of booths will be assigned by the Ag. Society. The Ag. Society reserves the right to move the exhibitor to a different location than provided on the contract agreement should it prove necessary. Ag. Society shall be the sole judge in determining what is necessary in the best interest of the Cuming County Fair and the public.
- 8) **Exhibitors may advertise at and distribute from their place of exhibit only.**
- 9) Rental fee must accompany signed contract agreement.
- 10) Ag. Society policy permits no camping on the grounds overnight. All vehicles must be parked in the parking lot after unloading merchandise in your booth, no parking between buildings.
- 11) The Ag. Society assumes no responsibility for any damage to exhibitor's exhibits, merchandise or concessions caused by thefts, wind, hail, fire, water or any cause whatsoever before, during or after Fair hours.
- 12) **Vendors assist with the sanitation efforts by moving all trash cans to the street at closing time,** the sanitation company will only empty cans that are accessible from the street.
- 13) Checks will not be deposited until July 1, 2025.
