Eligibility: Open to residents of Cuming County

Entry time: Tuesday, 12-9 p.m. in building #6

Exhibitors must pick up an exhibitor number from the Fair Office (building #4) prior to entering exhibit. Exhibits will be released on Sunday between 7:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.

Rules: The purpose of this class of exhibits is to encourage the production of flowers by all; hence, this class is open to amateurs only. Nurseries and florists may exhibit but are barred from competition.

Guidelines: Potted plants and cut flowers must be grown by the exhibitor at least six weeks prior to exhibiting. Plants and flowers should be named and classified into the category that is preferred. Any plant material showing signs of insect or fungal problems will be refused. Please include a liner or saucer to keep the display area clean. Foliage on cut flowers that is below the water line should be removed. Exhibitors are responsible for watering their entry and replenishing any wilted plant material so that things look fresh while on display.

The Judge has the right to award or withhold premium according to merit or exhibit.

One exhibit per entry.
